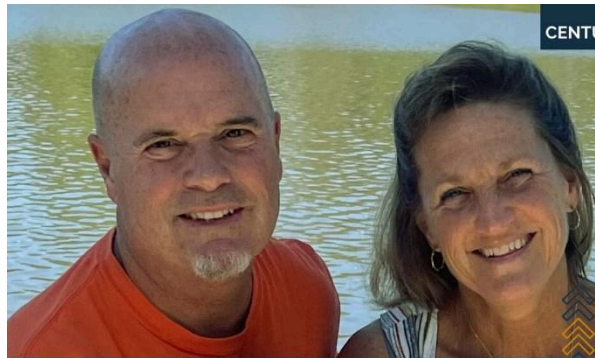


# MISSIONARIES THAT CBS SUPPORTS

#### 6.Italian Bible Institute in Rome:

IBEI's vision is to be a school available to all Italian evangelical churches to carry out a training service for the growth of the church in Italy, with the end result of propagating the Good News of salvation by grace alone through faith in Jesus Christ, and thus helping to fulfill Jesus' mandate, "Go and make disciples of all nations ... teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..." IBEI is an interdenominational ministry and considers the Bible as the absolute authority and reference regarding matters of faith, ethics and morals.

Our motto is "Prepared to Serve," which summarizes our mission to come alongside evangelical churches in the training of believers, broadening and deepening their biblical-theological knowledge, developing their practical and specific skills, and fostering their character and relational growth in the community context.

An emphasis is placed on teaching the Word of God, to implement the principle of 2 Timothy 2:2: "The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust them to faithful men...who are also able to teach others." To fulfill its mission, IBEI offers various educational services:

- at the basic level, through the IBEI-Emmaus Introduction to the Bible courses;
- at the academic level, through the Residential School, the Extension Schools and the Online Asynchronous School and the Online Synchronous School.

In addition, it offers conferences/seminars of various kinds, and publishes the theological journal Lux Biblica.

Not going to be working for Ethnos 360 anymore. Have already adopted Rovon from Madagascar, in process (for many ears) of adopting two sisters from Liberia. Liberia doesn't want to release them.



10..Rogers-living in & working in Mozambique. It's becoming too dangerous there, so they're also in transition, not sure they're going back or continue working for Ethnos 360. All Ethnos 360 personnel have been removed from Mozambique.



11.Eleanor Tuccelli-working for Ethnos 360 in the U.S.: involved in church planting, training, accounting for & transferring gifts, recruits missionaries, informs & involves churches & individuals. Responsible to raise financial support to pay their salaries & ministry expenses.



12. Frontier Ventures-Jim & Sterling O'Neill-Jim is director of Mobilization and Leadership Development. Sterling works as a consultant & Certified Life Coach.



13. Hearts for Heaven in Guatemala: Hearts for Heaven, Inc. is an evangelical mission dedicated to reaching the lost and discipling the saints in Guatemala. We strive to meet both physical and spiritual needs of children and others with the aim of having them become worshipers of Jesus and missionaries. We are guided by a Board of Directors. Our cofounder, Beth Briggs is now the Development Director and Kevin Miller is President. We are supported mainly by individuals and several churches from many denominations. HFH is a 501c3 organization so contributions are tax deductible. Our Guatemalan National Director named Oscar Martin leads everything from Bible Training to Construction projects. He is very enthusiastic about helping people experience and understand the love of Christ.

A large part of our ministry is the production of weekly Bible study material for children in about 70 churches. With those lessons we have the joy of training the teachers in those churches to become more effective Bible teachers. About 500 of these children are also served lunch every other day in several churches we work with.

14. Hope Mission-provides food, shelter, emergency financial assistance, emotional support, mentoring, & counseling for the needy in Carteret County.

15. Hopeforce International-Rene & Marianne Lako. They were in Haiti, but now living in Tennessee because the situation in Haiti has deteriorated so. They

provide food, uniforms, school materials to children in SouSavanne, Haiti. Rene has traveled there recently (end of 2024)



16.Intervarsity (Roanoke College)-Isaac Prock. Isaac is the campus staff minister whose passion is getting students to encounter the gospel, so they can live a life of joy while serving God.



17.Life in Messiah-Philippe & Analee Israels in Paris, France (France has the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest Jewish population in the world). Philippe engages in street & relational evangelism ministry. Analee manages the home.They have 5 boys of various ages: Eitan, Noah, Liam, Dany & Matteo

18.Tabers-Life in Messiah-Wes is the Global Ambassador & Executive Director Emeritus. Lori Taber is the Administrative Director.

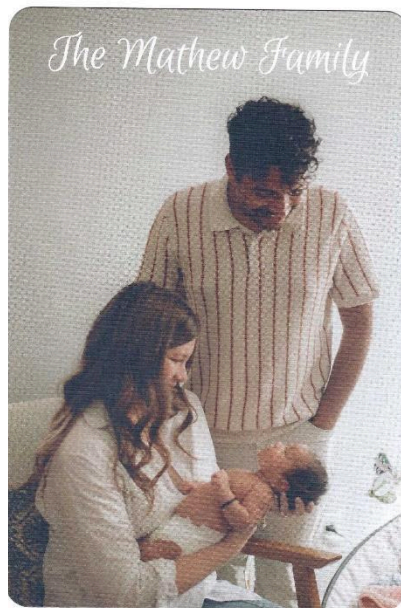
